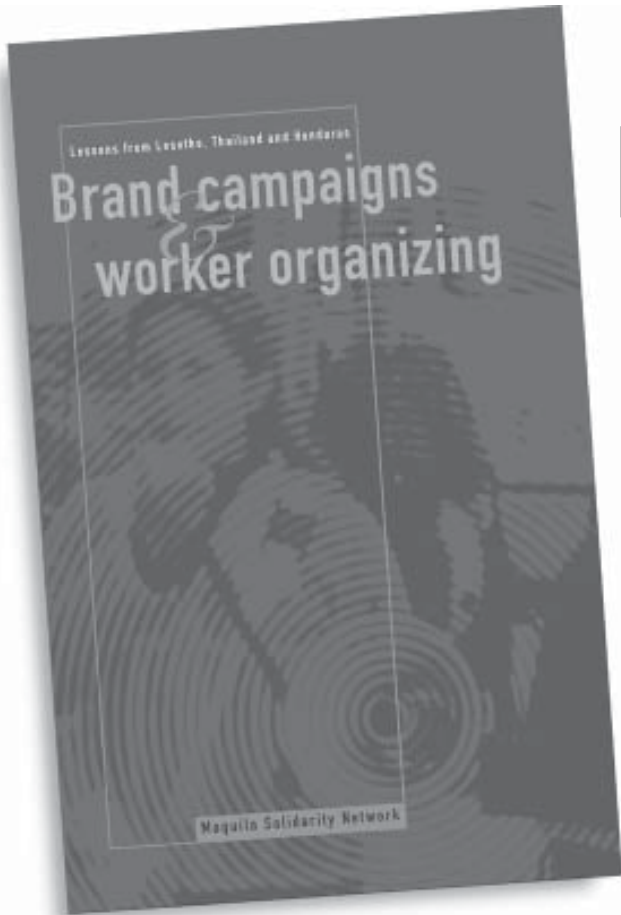


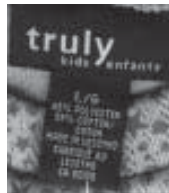
Lessons from Lesotho, Thailand and Honduras
